

RESOLUTION NO. 14-310

WHEREAS, in response to a 2006 League of California Cities assembly resolution encouraging cities to embrace policies that facilitate activities to promote healthier lifestyles and communities, including healthy diet and nutrition and adoption of city design and planning principles that enable citizens of all ages and abilities to undertake exercise; and

WHEREAS, the League of California Cities has a strategic goal to promote and develop safe and healthy cities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville will remain committed to land use policies and workplace wellness initiatives that support a healthy eating and active living city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Roseville supports wellness initiatives within the organization and looks for ways to promote physical activity and healthy nutrition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Roseville that the City of Roseville planners, engineers, park and recreation department, development services, and economic development personnel responsible for the design and construction of parks, neighborhoods, streets, and business areas, should make every effort to:

- Continue to plan and construct an environment that encourages walking, biking and other forms of physical activity; and
- Continue to address walking and biking connectivity between residential neighborhoods and schools, parks, recreational resources, and retail; and
- Continue to expand community access to indoor and outdoor public facilities through joint use agreements with schools and/or other partners.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to promote wellness initiatives as an employer, the City of Roseville will:

- Continue to offer employee health tips and special events (i.e. wellness center, walking challenge, biking incentives, etc.); and
- Continue to accommodate breastfeeding employees upon their return to work; and
- Continue to support active lifestyles amongst its employee population.
