

RESOLUTION NO. 8396

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2011-12 BUDGET TO BECOME A MEMBER OF CALIFORNIA HEALTHY EATING AND COMMUNITIES NETWORK, JOIN THE LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES HEALTHY EATING, ACTIVE LIVING CITIES CAMPAIGN AND ACCEPT A SPONSORSHIP BY KAISER PERMANENTE FOR THE NETWORK ANNUAL DUES

WHEREAS, obesity-related illness and poor nutrition are becoming major health problems throughout the nation;

WHEREAS, the City of Whittier has one of the highest obesity rates in Los Angeles County for both children and adults;

WHEREAS, many serious health problems can be directly related to obesity, including type 2 diabetes, heart disease, hypertension, stroke, cancer and arthritis;

WHEREAS, in 2008, Activate Whittier, a non-profit group with partners including the City of Whittier, the Greater Whittier YMCA, Presbyterian Intercommunity Hospital, Kaiser Permanente, the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, First Day, Boys and Girls Club and Whittier College, was established to address the serious problem of obesity-related illness and other wellness concerns;

WHEREAS, the City of Whittier is already supporting a higher level of fitness for its residents through exercise and fitness recreation programs;

WHEREAS, the City of Whittier constructed the Greenway Trail, a hiking and biking trail and encourages residents to utilize the Trail to get more exercise and improve their level of fitness;

WHEREAS, the 1988 Public Health Institute initiated the California Healthy Cities and Communities and in 2004 the League of California Cities adopted the Healthy Eating, Active Living Cities Campaign;

WHEREAS, these two organizations can provide valuable resources for the City of Whittier to utilize in its efforts to improve the health, fitness and nutrition of its residents and aid in the fight against obesity;

WHEREAS, Kaiser Permanente Downey Medical Center has offered to sponsor the \$250 annual fee for membership in California Healthy Cities; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the 2011-12 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WHITTIER, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Whittier will become a member of California Healthy Eating and Communities Network and join the League of California Cities Healthy Eating, Active Living Cities Campaign.

SECTION 2. The following appropriations shall be added to the City FY 2011-2012 budget:
